BABY GREEN - Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No rider restrictions. Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

LOW HUNTER - Open to all horses and ponies and riders with no age limitations. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

ADULT HUNTER DIVISION - Open to horses ridden by riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 3'. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

NOVICE HUNTER DIVISION - Open to any rider who is eligible for novice adult or novice junior equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations. Fences not to exceed 2'0".

JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER - Open to all except professional riders. No horse restrictions. Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". No combinations.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY - Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Small ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump 2'. Medium ponies, 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 to jump 2'3". Large ponies, over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 to jump 2'6". Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. NOTE: Children's Hunter may be run together as long as riders designate horse or pony.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE - Open to horses to be shown by junior riders. Riders over 15 years of age must still be eligible for Limit equitation over fences (i.e., they have not won 6 equitation blues over fences) as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 3' for horses. Note: if 6 or more of each (horses and ponies) are entered in this class, it should be split. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

OPEN WORKING / JUNIOR HUNTER - Fences to be 3'. No restrictions on age or status of rider except in Junior Hunter. Judged on manners, suitability and soundness.

PLEASURE DIVISION - May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Martingales not permitted.

WALK TROT - Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for a year-end participation ribbon, riders must accumulate a minimum of 28 points throughout the season. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to riders 12 and under, who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to riders 13 and older (including amateur adults), who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 18". No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

PRE-CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION - Open to riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3 in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'6". Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'0. No combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

CHILDREN'S EQUITATION - Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6 in a recognized show, except riders may show in equitation classes where fence height does not exceed 2'9". Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6 with at least one change of direction. No combinations.

MODIFIED JUNIOR EQUITATION - Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9 with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

JUNIOR EQUITATION - Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre Children's or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional.

ADULT EQUITATION - Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'9".

POINT VALUE - The points in all classes will be scored as follows:

Show Rules & Regulations

- No dogs brought to show grounds.
- Division entry fees will not be refunded after the start of the first class in the division. All scratches must be made directly with the Show Secretary.
- Each exhibitor or trainer must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
- Management reserves the right to charge double the entry fee to anyone showing in a class they have not entered prior to the start of the class.
- A processing fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all checks returned by the bank for any reason.
- All riders must wear protective headgear while riding anywhere on the show grounds.
- All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management will not be responsible for any accident, which may occur to any rider, driver, groom, attendants or equipment at the show.
- The management reserves the right to decline any entry and return the entry fee without being liable for compensation.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any event that has less than 3 entries.
- The Officials listed have been invited to officiate. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary these names if circumstances require it.

Every entry at a recognized competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include without limitation, the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler and horse) for themselves, their Principals, Representatives, Employees and Agents (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the Association and the local rules of the Competition. (2) represent that every Horse, Rider, Driver and Handler is eligible as entered. (3) agree to be bound by the Constitution and rules of the WNE-PHA and of the Competition, and will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the Competition, the WNE-PHA, their Officials, Directors and employees harmless for any action taken. (4) that the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler and Horse agree to hold the Competition, WNE-PHA, their Officials, Directors and Employees harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in conjunction with the Competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said Officials, Directors, Employees or Agents of the WNE-PHA or Competition.
